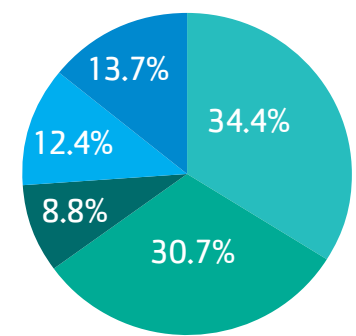

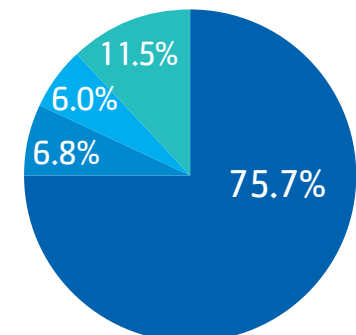

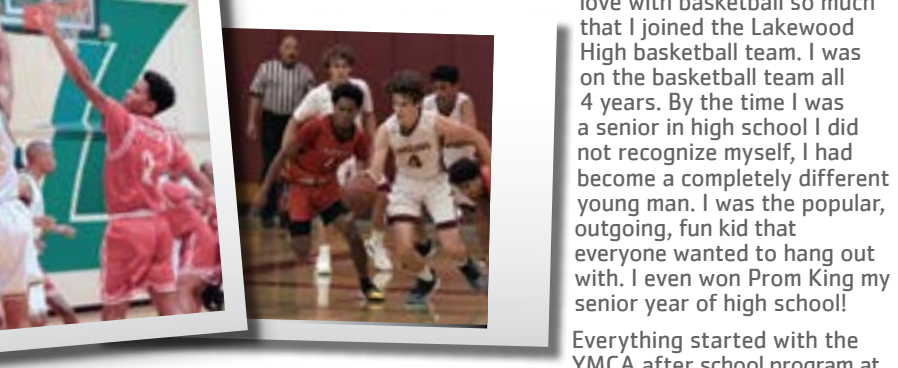

A PLACE CALLED HOME

The YMCA has been a place that I have called home since I started attending Hoover Middle School in 2016. I was a very shy kid with little to no friends. Since my parents each had full time jobs, I had nowhere to go each day when school was out. They enrolled me in the YMCA after school program, ASES. I remember being furious because I hated being at school and was terrible at making new friends. Little did I know that it would change my life forever.

Once I joined the YMCA after school program, I learned to make new friendships that would last a lifetime. I remember the staff having a positive impact. They were kind, fun, and really cared about their kids. That made me want to come back to the Y every day. The YMCA gave me a sense of belonging that I had never experienced in my life. By making new friends and new mentors, I was able to find confidence in myself and explore who I was meant to be. By spending time in the after school program, I was able to play basketball during our "club time." Because of the YMCA after school program, I was able to build a talent and a passion for basketball. In sixth grade I gained enough confidence to join my school's basketball team. I played ball like the court was mine. I was able to make new friends on and off the court. The Y was giving me the boost that I longed for as a teenager.

My story does not end there, I continued to play basketball through 8th grade where we won City Nationals! I remember our staff leader, Josue Montenegro, who would push me so hard and would train us on and off the court. It was truly a character-building experience. When I left Hoover Middle School it was a complete heartbreak because my high school was not going to have an after school program run by the YMCA, therefore I knew my experience was going to be different. So, I decided to return and volunteer at Hoover Middle School throughout my high school years. I also fell in love with basketball so much that I joined the Lakewood High basketball team. I was on the basketball team all 4 years. By the time I was a senior in high school I did not recognize myself, I had become a completely different young man. I was the popular, outgoing, fun kid that everyone wanted to hang out with. I even won Prom King my senior year of high school!



Everything started with the YMCA after school program at Hoover Middle School. I am now 19 years old, and I play college basketball. This year I have decided that I want to give back to my community, I don't have millions in my bank account yet, but I do have time. So, this summer I'm working as a summer staff at the YMCA summer program at Hoover Middle School, to give these young youth the experience I received when I was attending the YMCA after school program there. It's great because Josue Montenegro is no longer my staff, but my manager and an ongoing life mentor. The world works in mysterious ways, and I am extremely thankful for it.
